

Running LSB Selector Software with newer versions of Windows

Fix 1 (Running Program as Administrator)

- Step 1: Right click on LSB3.2 desktop icon
- Step 2: Scroll down, and click "Properties"
- Step 3: Under "Properties", click the "Compatibility" tab
- Step 4: Under "Privilege Level" Click the check box, "Run this program as an administrator"
- Step 5: Click the "Security" tab and ensure that all permissions are allowed for all users

NOTE: This fix will only need to be done once, and does not require the adjustment of UAC.

Fix 2 (Compatibility)

If the previous fix does not work, keep all the settings changed for Fix 1 in addition to the changes below.

- Step 1: Right click on LSB3.2 desktop icon
- Step 2: Scroll down, and click "Properties"
- Step 3: Under "Properties", click the "Compatibility" tab
- Step 4: Click the check box, "Run this program in compatibility mode for:"
- Step 5: In the drop down menu, choose "Windows XP (Service Pack 3)"
- Step 6: You may or may not need to reboot your computer for the changes to take effect

NOTE: This fix will only need to be done once, and does not require the adjustment of UAC.

Fix 3 (User Account Controls):

- Step 1: Open the Control Panel
- Step 2: In Control Panel search box, type: "UAC"
- Step 3 in Vista: Click the link "Turn off User Account Control (UAC)"
- Step 4 in Vista: Uncheck the box "Use User Account Control (UAC) to help protect your computer"
- Step 3 in 7: Click the link, "Change User Account Control settings"
- Step 4 in 7: Move the slider to desired level. Various levels may be checked to see if the LSB selector software works at this level.
- Step 5: In both versions of Windows, you will need to reboot your computer for the adjustments to take effect.

NOTE: The UAC will need to remain at the adjusted level to run, but may be adjusted back to the original position when not running the software.
